

SHOWROOM PRICE TICKETS

OVERVIEW:

Product pricing in a showroom is an ongoing task that requires maintenance continually. To alleviate the difficulty in printing current price tickets manually, a system has been set up within JDE to make the process quick and simple. There are multiple reasons why additional price tickets would be required to be printed. Price changes, new parts added to merchandising zone, store specific displays, replacements, duplicates, brand new store openings etc

WHICH PARTS:

Specific merchandising zones have been set up to include any showroom products that could be on display depending on the store style.

Zones included are: Touring, Roof Racks, Power accessories, Driving Lights, Winches, Recovery gear, Apparel, Air systems, Bushranger products, Add ons & Fridges

Should you find any showroom products that are not included in the merchandising zones, please advise National Sales to have them added.

2	Self-print stores	National Sales	Email PDF file for printing in store
3	Non-print stores	National Sales	Print showroom tickets at HO and dispatch to stores

HOW TO: REQUEST NEW TICKETS

If additional or new tickets are required - Send a list of part numbers in excel document through to National Sales to generate PDF.

Advise pricing scale - **Metro or Regional** and **format required** (PDF for self-print or printed)

HOW TO: SELF-PRINT

Using Acrobat Reader to open the Showroom price ticket PDF.

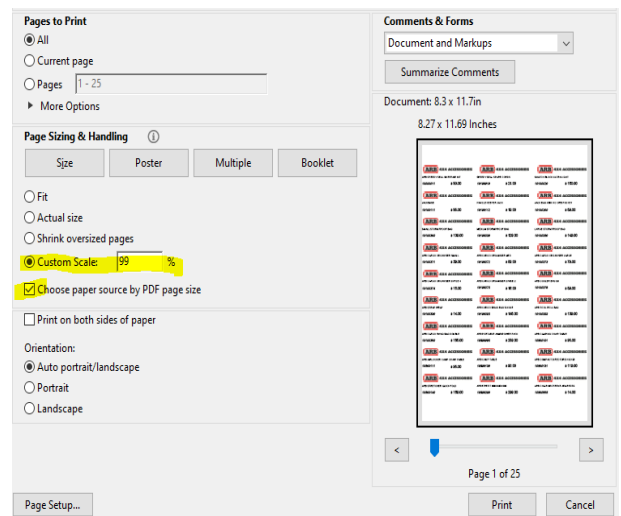
Select '**Print**' - In dialog box selected desired pages to print (All, Current or Page selection)

Select '**Custom Scale**' and change to **99%**

Select check box for '**Choose paper source by PDF page size**'

Load perforated paper (Part # 570150) into printer and print

*Always perform a test print on a single page first



ADHOC TICKETS - For single tickets the 'Ticket Template' form can be used to create them instore. This is not recommended to large quantities.
